



**Formal and informal responses to student-student sexual violence and harassment in higher education
(3 hours)**

This training uses case study and active learning to explore what HEIs and relevant staff can do when a student makes a disclosure of SVHM. Starting with a review of key disclosure response skills, it moves on to consider what happens next. Options are mapped in relation to cases where there is a formal report, but also considers what can be done in the absence of a formal report, both in terms of support for the disclosing student and addressing risk to the wider university community.

Aims

- To understand the context relating to SVHM in higher education
- To enhance understanding of good and poor responses to a disclosure
- To become familiar with reporting options
- To build knowledge of how reporting is experienced by reporting parties and relevant protective factors
- To understand the role of precautionary/interim/risk mitigation measures following a report
- To explore informal adjustments and support options
- To explore alternate/informal resolution in student-to-student cases
- To be introduced to risk assessment and mitigation
